

The London Marriott Hotel Grosvenor Square – Mayfair's destination hotel for tomorrow

Situated in the heart of Mayfair and originally built as a stately townhouse, the **London Marriott Hotel Grosvenor Square** has undergone a major £19 million pound refurbishment which will take the hotel in an ultra-luxurious and contemporary direction. Completed in April 2009, the project includes the creation of 45 Club rooms and suites (12 with a private garden); 92 standard Deluxe and Superior bedrooms; an exclusive Club Lounge; 4 new meeting rooms and a new restaurant – **maze Grill** – created by Gordon Ramsay and Jason Atherton, complete with three elegant private dining rooms. **United Designers** are responsible for the project, taking all aspects of the hotel forward to the modern day with sensitivity and style in a bold design statement for a branded hotel group.

Inspired by the grand residences of Mayfair, the **Marriott Grosvenor Square** has been designed as a contemporary take on a London townhouse. It is the epitome of Englishness; harking back to the very things that Mayfair is renowned for, and reinterpreting these aspects to the modern day with sensitivity and style including unique features such as fireplaces, four poster beds, rose gardens and oak floors. **maze Grill** has an informal, warm, lived-in feel, combined with contemporary architecture and sensibility to impart the feeling of a modern townhouse kitchen, while the private dining rooms provide more formal, glamorous entertaining spaces. The project has also maximised the limited space of the building's footprint by housing new meeting rooms, Club Lounge, gymnasium and cloakrooms in a disused basement car park. A new striking double-entranced marble staircase now leads down from the lobby to this reclaimed space.
